All older 7AC, 7ACA, S7AC, 7BCM, 7CCM, S7CCM, 7DC, S7DC, 7EC, S7EC, 7ECA, 7FC, 7GCA, 7GCAA, 7GCBA, 7GCBA, 7GCBC, 7HC, 7JC, 7KC, 7KCAB, 8KCAB, and 8GCBC with Folding Front Seats that have complied with AD 89-18-06 via replacement seat frame 7-1513 (adjustable) or 7-1454 (fixed)

before the date of this letter.

Description:

During an isolated case of a front seat failure, it was discovered a small batch of seat frames did not contain the required 2-2166 reinforcement truss. That batch has been isolated and the problem resolved. In an effort to ensure this has not happened in the past, American Champion requests a one time inspection of the assembly.

Note:

This inspection does not replace the requirements of AD 89-18-06.

The inspection procedures described herein are not intended to be a substitute for a properly performed 100 hour / annual inspection. Refer to Advisory Circular (AC) 43.13-1B: Acceptable Methods, Techniques, and Practices: Aircraft Inspection and

Repair.

Procedure:




Figure 1 Location of 2-2166 Reinforcement Truss

No removal of parts should be necessary to do the inspection. Referring to Figure 1, visually inspect both sides of the front seat bottom for the indicated truss section. If a 2-2166 truss is missing, contact American Champion for corrective action options.
